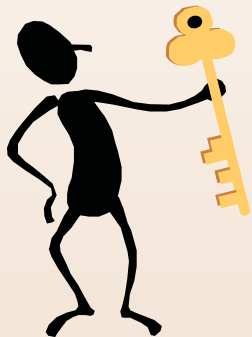

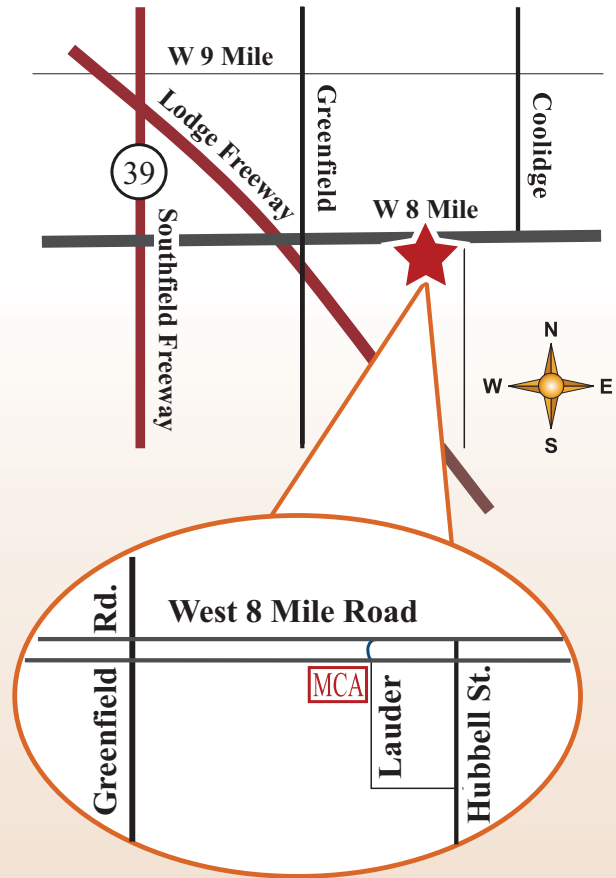
INSTRUCTOR BIO
