RE: Appropriate Pay Rate for the Holidays - General Reminder

The Holidays are upon us and we wanted to remind everyone of the pay schedules for each of the Holidays below.

### **Thanksgiving**

Thanksgiving is listed as one of the observed Holidays in both the Local Agreements between MCA, Local 98 and Local 636 and the NMA Agreement. Any Employee working this day under any of these Agreements is to be paid at the Double Time rate.

### Friday following Thanksgiving

**Local Agreements between MCA and Local 98 or Local 636** – Any Employee working under the Local Agreement is paid at the Straight Time Rate as the Local Agreements do **not** recognize this day as a Holiday.

**NMA** – The NMA allows for a floating Holiday. The Greater Detroit Building Trades have chosen to observe the floating Holiday on the Friday following Thanksgiving (see attached notice). Due to this the Friday after Thanksgiving is a holiday for Employees working <u>under the NMA</u> and any Employee performing work under the NMA is to be paid at the Double Time rate.

## Christmas Day and New Year's Day

Both Christmas Day and New Year's Day fall on a Thursday this year. In both the Local Agreements between MCA, Local 98 and Local 636 and the NMA Agreement. Any Employee working on either of these Thursdays are to be paid at the Double Time rate.
